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## COALITION SEEKS SPONSORS FOR 4<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL "STORYBOOK FOREST" EVENT

*The event, which drew more than 900 community members in 2012, is held in honor of the 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Children's Week presented by Comcast, a statewide celebration of Early Childhood Education that brings awareness to legislators and community leaders.*
